## Our Goal: Strengthening Recovery within the Fellowship

- We sponsored the annual January share-a-thon, a chat on retention of newcomers, and a discussion on Sponsorship.
- We held three "Actions in Recovery" discussions.
- We implemented our first annual Just Ask Us (JAUs) event.
- We maintained and distributed our Getting Started list—a list of members willing to help newcomers get started.
- We maintained and distributed a printed version quarterly to individual meetings.
- We communicated with local members through our community e-mail list.
- We completed a membership survey regarding events, and we adjusted our event planning accordingly, including shorter
  events and offering to bring events to individual meetings.
- Our Service & Inclusion team identified new trusted servants: Calendar Coordinator; Twelfth Step Within Coordinator and Volunteers; Web Share Coordinator.
- Upon reguest, our Chair shared with individual members a brief list (2016) of Region 6 members willing to be sponsors.
- We supplied individual meetings with Anorexia/Bulimia packets and Is Food a Problem for You? pamphlets.
- We established an annual budget process.
- We broadened our guidelines for financial support for meetings.
- We supplied financial support to a meeting to purchase literature.
- We broadened our efforts to find trusted servants for non-officer positions.

## Our Goal: Spreading the Message of OA to those Outside the Fellowship

- We strengthened our website by posting monthly Important Dates for NYS Capital District OA Members.
- Our website provides a .pdf version of the most recent meeting list and bullet points from our monthly IG meetings.
- We maintained our Answerphone service: an outgoing message listing individual meetings; return calls; OA entry in local telephone directories.
- A member spoke at a class for those studying to be addiction counselors.
